DRAFT MINUTES

May 10, 2012

Parks:

- Wiseman:
 - Drinking fountain will be turned on before end of month.
 - Commissioners will spray for creeping Charlie
 - With help from local teens, the gazebo will be treated with oil
- Armstrong Woods:
 - Brush on paths and debris needs chipping. Commissioners will address
- Prairie Area:
 - Pine has been replaced, at no charge, by Hinsdale Nursery
 - Complaints from residents living in area about Greeney Lawn Service. Trucks are damaging private property when turning around. Repeated calls to company have not be returned.
 - Matter will be referred to Board contact Pat Cahill, and partial payment will be withheld until matter is addressed satisfactorily. Also, garbage containers have not been emptied.

There has been official contact with FCWRD since last meeting.

Old Business:

- Winter Fest is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, Dec. 2nd. Carriage company has reserved date.
- Review of responsibilities for May 25th concert.

- Waiting for data from BP, as promised by representative from firm BP hired to clear cut the area at west side of Armstrong Woods.
- There has been no response from Homes Association to our written request for canvas sides on pavilion in Zimmerman Park.

New Business:

- Request by resident for bocce ball court in Wiseman Park. Motion did not pass. Feeling that there is not sufficient area in Wiseman to properly establish a court. Suggestion to refer request to Homes.
